

Karaoke Contest Rules

- 1. Must be an OFFICIAL anime, video game, J-Pop/J-Rock, K-Pop, or Vocaloid song. Fan-Made and Western Songs are *not* accepted.
- 2. Your song cannot be more than 3 minutes.
- 3. Keep the song PG-13; make sure that there is no profanity, offensive language, or sexually explicit lines.
- 4. You may compete as a soloist, a duet, or a group. Please note that only one prize will be given across the board.
- 5. When selecting your track, you must ensure that there are no other vocals. We want to hear your voice, not the original vocalists.
- 6. Props are only permitted on stage if they are relevant to your costume/cosplay. They cannot make noise that will disrupt your performance (instruments, noise makers, etc).
- 7. You may not sing in the acapella style. You must provide a backing track.
- 8. You may not interact with the judges, MC, or staff during your performance.
- 9. You may not interact with the audience (coordinating a fan club, going into the audience, inviting the audience on stage). However, you may invite the audience to clap along.
- 10. In the event of a tie, the ruling will be made by the majority vote of the judges.
- 11. If you are the winner, you will be permitted to sing a second song of your choice (following the previously stated guidelines) as a "victory lap".
- 12. You agree to abide by all FreeCon, FSU, and staff regulations.

Judge Criteria

- 1. Judges will be looking for your knowledge of your song, your stage presence, showmanship, and how appropriate your selected song is for you as the vocalist.
- 2. Score sheets remain confidential. At no point will you be allowed to see your score or someone else's. All rulings by the judges are final.
